On the afternoon of Tuesday, Dec. 1, the district was notified that a student at Calvin Coolidge Elementary School tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. Information regarding this individual's identity cannot be released. We ask that you please respect this person's privacy. This individual will be placed in isolation for the mandated number of days.

District officials are assisting the Broome County Health Department with a contact tracing investigation, and are promptly reaching out to those likely to be contacted by the health department upon news of this positive result and instructing them to stay home tomorrow.

If there was any person in direct or proximate contact with this individual, they will be placed in quarantine, per New York State Department of Health guidelines. The impacted area of the building is being disinfected.

Exposure to COVID-19 can occur from any person-to-person or proximate contact. There are several steps that can minimize the spread of all respiratory illnesses, including COVID-19, according to the New York State Department of Health:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water is not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

We will continue to notify you of any additional cases of COVID-19 in this building, and will notify employees and families immediately in the event of any interruptions to the school schedule. We realize this is a serious matter of great concern, and we appreciate your patience and understanding.
