BCSD Delays In-Person Learning Until Feb. 1:

The Binghamton City School District made the decision to have students not return to our school buildings following the winter break because of the pending threat of an increase number of positive COVID cases in the City of Binghamton, and subsequently, an increase in positive cases among students and employees. While we have not realized a significant increase in positive cases among employees, we have seen an increase in both the city and amongst our student population. While the increase has appeared to peak, it has not yet decreased to the level prior to moving to full remote instruction. Due to the continuation of high level of positive cases within the community, the Binghamton City School District will delay in-person learning for an additional two weeks, and begin in-person instruction on Monday, Feb. 1.

Deadline to Change Learning Mode:

The district is offering families the option to change their student's learning mode for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year. Families who wish to change their child's method of instruction should do so by Jan. 15 [using this form](#). If we do not receive notification by Jan. 15, your child's current form of instructional delivery will remain the same. The change in learning mode will take place on Feb. 1.
