## **Updated Meal Schedule:**

Below is an outline of the district's updated meal schedule, which will begin during the first full week of October. A detailed letter is being mailed to families this week.

### ***Pre-K - 2<sup>nd</sup> Starting October 5<sup>th</sup>***

Students in these grades will receive one (1) days' worth of meals for Wednesdays while they are learning remotely. Students will be given their meals on Tuesday afternoon before leaving the building for the day.

### ***Hybrid Model Starting October 5<sup>th</sup>***

Students choosing a hybrid model will receive three (3) meals for each school day they are learning remotely. Students will be given their meals on the last day they are physically in school each week before leaving the building for the day (Cohort A on Tuesdays, Cohort B on Fridays).

### ***100% Virtual Model Starting October 5<sup>th</sup>***

Students choosing to be 100% virtual will have the option to receive meals on Wednesdays both during the day and evening. Food distribution will be available at the closest school location for your child during the day. We will have three (3) evening pick up locations. Students will receive five (5) days' worth of breakfast and lunch.

### ***Wednesday during the day - 100% Virtual Meal Pick-Up***

All K-8 Schools: 11 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Binghamton High School: 9:45 a.m. – 1 p.m.

### ***Wednesday Evenings - 100% Virtual Meal Pick-Up***

Theodore Roosevelt Elementary School - 3:30 - 5:30 p.m.

Benjamin Franklin Elementary School – 3:30 – 5:30 p.m.

Woodrow Wilson Elementary School – 3:30 – 5:30 p.m.

## **GoCanvas App for Daily Screenings:**

Families will be asked to complete a short check each morning and report your child's information on **Monday or Thursday**, whichever is your child's first day of school that week. The district has purchased an application called GoCanvas to make this process as easy as possible. The application
